



Check the new resolution regarding the entry of drones into the national territory

Resolution 000242 of 2025 establishes new provisions for controlling the entry and importation of drones and their components into Colombian territory, with the aim of strengthening national security and preventing their use in illicit activities. The National Tax and Customs Directorate is introducing customs measures aimed at improving oversight of these devices, effective as of January 11th, 2026.

Among the main provisions is the **requirement to submit an import declaration in advance for unmanned** aircraft systems (UAS), as well as for their parts and spare parts. Additionally, entry points into the country are restricted, allowing imports only through **El Dorado International Airport in Bogotá** and the **ports of the Cartagena Regional Customs Directorate**.

The resolution also **prohibits the entry of drones via postal traffic and express shipments**, in order to prevent this equipment from entering the country through channels that are difficult to control. Travelers entering the country with drones must **declare them using the appropriate form to the customs authority**, which helps strengthen control mechanisms for these devices.
